Science – Living things and their habitats

Children will be learning to recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways by exploring and using classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment. They will also be learning environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

Languages

The children will participate in weekly Italian sessions learning a range of words and common phrases. Children will continue to have short conversations in Italian and build on the vocabulary they learning.

Sculpture

The children will begin to develop art techniques linked to sculpture and given opportunity to explore these creatively using their own ideas. Children will be learning about great artists from history who have used sculpture as their medium.

Children will develop their understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be resaved and reused. They will consider the impact that editing images can have, and evaluate the effectiveness of their choices.
